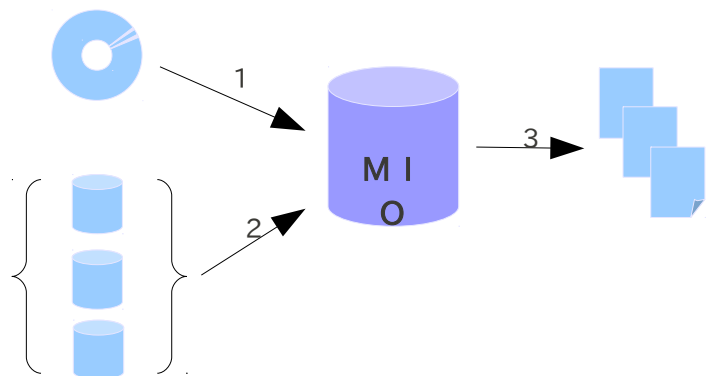
MIO is organization
